thirty Nicholas Jordan a customary tenant of the

hands of the Lord of the said Manor by the hands of John Townsend one
of His Majesty's Justices there by the road One Cottage or tenement in Siddington
aforesaid formerly in the tenure of Thomas Coleman ^{late} in the tenure
or occupation of Edward Rowlett with the appurtenances within the said
Manor aforesaid to the use behoof of Robert Dexter of
Langham in the County of Rutland Cooper and his
Heirs and Assignes for ever according to the Custom of
the said manor.
