

This Indenture

made the ffive and twentieth Day of August in the Sevynth year of the Reigne of our Soueraine Lord Charles by the grace of God of England Scotland France and Ireland King Defender of the faith &c. Betweene the Right honorable william Earle of Exeter Baron of Buryley one of the Lords of his Ma^{ty} Most honorable Privie Councill and Knight of the most noble order of the Garter, the honorable Sir Richard Scull xxx of Waterley in the Countie of Northton Knight & David Scull of Keston in the Countie of Rutland Esq^r on the one part And Thomas Poole of Ludington in the said Countie of Rutland husbandman on the other part. **witneseth** that the said william Earle of Exeter & Richard Scull & David Scull aforesaid in Consideration of the Surrender of a former Lease of the particulars hereafter mentioned at assise of a competent summe of Lawfull money of England in hand paid to the said william Earle of Exeter by the said Thomas Poole before the dealing & deliv^r hereof have demised grante and to farme Letten And by their assent doe demise grante and to farme Letten unto the said Thomas Poole Myne & Armes and three roods of Arable land lyinge & halfe an acre of Meadow wh^{ch} they pertained by lease and boosome unto the said Thomas Poole above said and now in the possession or usurpation of him the said Thomas Poole or his assignes. **To have and to holde** the demised premises and diverse parts thereof unto the said Thomas Poole his exors^{els} Administrato^{rs} and assignes from the tyme of the makinge hereof unto the full end and terme of thre score & thre years from thence next ensuynge and fullie to be compleate and ended (if he the said Thomas Poole Robert his sonne and Anne his daughter or any one of them shall so longe live) **yeeldinge and payynge** therefor yearly duringe the said terme the rent of Six Shillinges & eight pence of Lawfull mony of England at the feaste of S^t Michael the Archangell & the Annuntiatione of the Blessed Virgyn Marie by even and equal portions fowre times off shroott cleane well dressed & Marchantable Beanes at good as Stamford Market cam afford at the feaste of Pentecost next And if it shall happen the said yearly rent of Six Shillinges and eight pence or any parte thereof to be behinde and unpaid by the space of fower tyme dayes next after the said feaste of the said Beanes wheratt the same ought to be paid at aforesaid (beinge Lawfullie demanded) Then & from thenceforth it shall and may be Lawfull to and for the said william Earle of Exeter duringe his naturall life and after his decease to such other person and persons as shall have the next and ymediate Reversion and remainder of the demised premises into the demised premises and diverse parts thereof to receive and the same to possess & have againe as in his and their owne right and former estate Any thinge herein Contained to the contrary notwithstandinge. **And** if it shall happen the said yearly rent Beanes or any part thereof to be behinde and unpaid by the space of six dayes next after the feaste of Pentecost at the same ought to be paid at aforesaid (beinge Lawfullie demanded) Then shall the said Thomas Poole his exors^{els} Administrato^{rs} and assignes forfeite and paye unto the said william Earle of Exeter duringe his naturall life and after his decease to such other person and persons as shall have the next and ymediate Reversion and remainder of the demised premises Six Shillinges & eight pence of Lawfull mony of England (Nomine pene) and as much more in six dayes ^{after that} until the said yearly rent Beanes or all the arerages thereof be fullie satisfied & paid. **And** the said Thomas Poole doth hereby for himselfe his exors^{els} Administrato^{rs} and assignes Comynge promise and grante to and with the said william Earle of Exeter his heires & assignes That he the said Thomas Poole his exors^{els} Administrato^{rs} and assignes shall and will from tyme to tyme duringe the said terme upon warning or notice given well and lawfully pforme & doe his and their suite and service to the Do^{or} Loote and Do^{or} Baron of the said william Earle of Exeter his heires and assignes to be held them or for the memo^{ry} of Ludington aforesaid wher and at often as they or either of them shall happen to be kept, And well and lawfully pforme & observe & keepe all the pointes & qualites & othe^r bylawes and Constitutiones whiche shall be made aforesaid or imposed upon him or them by the Steward and Jurors of the said Do^{or} or either of them for the tyme beinge. **And** likewise shall and will from tyme to tyme duringe the said terme Grinde all his and their owne graine and Maill wh^{ch} he or they shall oppone upon the premises at the Mill or Mills of the said william Earle of Exeter his heires & assignes at Ludington aforesaid And paye the Toll accustomed for the same. **And** lawfully shall and will duringe the said terme w^{ith} such a competent number of Servants or other workfolles persons as shall be needfull and w^{ith} his and their Cart waine, beastes Cartell poles & furniture thereunto belonginge Boone & labour thre dayes in the weeke service and Busines of the said william Earle of Exeter duringe his naturall life and after his decease of such other person and persons as shall have the next and ymediate reversion and remainder of the demised premises upon warning or notice given unto him or them for the same. **And** the said william Earle of Exeter doth hereby for himselfe his heires & assignes Comynge promise and grante to and with the said Thomas Poole his exors^{els} Administrato^{rs} and assignes that it shall and may be Lawfull to & for him and them for and under the rent and Comynge above mentioned p^{er}ceivably and quietly to have hold possess and enjoy the demised premises & diverse parts thereof duringe the said terme w^{ith}out the Lawfull let trouble molestacion or interruption of the said william Earle of Exeter his heires & assignes. **And** the said Sir Richard Scull & David Scull doe hereby likewise for them selves their heires & assignes Comynge promise & grante to and with the said Thomas Poole his exors^{els} Administrato^{rs} and assignes That it shall and may be Lawfull to & for him & them for and under the rent & Comynge above mentioned p^{er}ceivably & quietly to have hold possess and enjoy the demised premises & diverse parts thereof duringe the said terme w^{ith}out the Lawfull let trouble molestacion or interruption of the said Sir Richard Scull and David Scull or either of them their or either of their heires or assignes or any of them or any Claymynge by from or under them or any of them. **In witness** whereof the parties to this Indenture have hereunto set their hands &
