**This Indenture** made the twentyith day of August in the Sixteenth year of the reigne of our Soveraigne Lord Charles by the grace of God King of England Scotland France and Ireland Defender of the faith &c Betwene the right hon<sup>e</sup> William Earl of Exeter Baron of Burghley one of the Lords of his Ma<sup>t</sup>e most hon<sup>e</sup> privie Councill and Knight of the most noble Ordre of the Garter the hon<sup>e</sup> Richard Scall of Waterly in the Countie of Northamton Knight and David Scall of Lepton in the xxix Countie of Rutland Esq; on the one part And Isabell Sismye x. of Liddington in the said County of Rutland widow on the other part **witnesseth**

that they the said william Earle of Exeter Richard Scall and David Scall as well in consideration of the Surrender of a former lease of the particulars hereafter mentioned as also of a competent sume of lawfull money of England in hand paid to the said william Earle of Exeter by the said Isabell Sismye before the Sealing and Delivry hereof have dimissh granted and to farme left onto the said Isabell Sismye fowre acres and one butt of arable land and byts one rood of meadowe halfe an acre of Headmire called Stintgrasse and halfe an acre of meadowe called the Demeains meadowe with the appurtenances lyng and being in the fields and territoris of Liddington aforesaid and late in the possession or occupacion of Richard Sismye or his assignes **to haue and to houde** the dimissh premisses and to receive part therof onto the said Isabell Sismye her executo<sup>r</sup> administrato<sup>r</sup> and assignes from the time of the making hereof unto the full end and termes of fourtye and twentynone yeareis from thence next the same and fullie to be compleate and ended (if the said Isabell Sismye Joane Sismye and Elizabeth Sismye her daughters or ame one of them shall so longe live) **yeeldinge and payinge** therfore yearly during the said termes the rent of myne shillings of lanfull mony of England (west) for the land ley and meadowe thre shillings and six pence for the Headmire called Stintgrasse two shillings and two pence and for the Meadowe called the Demeain meadowe thre shillings and six pence att the feaste of St. Michall the Archangell and the Ommacowd of the blessed virgyn Marie by bothe and equal proportionis **And** if it shall happen the said yearly rent of myne shillings or ame part therof to be behind and unpaid by the space of fourtye daies next after either of the said feastes wherat the same ought to be paid as aforesaid beme lawfullie demandid then and thonforth it shall and may be lawfull to and for the said william Earle of Exeter during his naturall life and after his dease to such other person and persons as shall haue the next and ymediate possession and remainder of the dimissh premisses into the dimissh premisses and to their part therof to enter and the same to receyve and haue againe as in his and their owne right and former estate and chyngi herim continued to the contrarie notwithstanding **And** the said Isabell Sismye doth herby for herself her executo<sup>r</sup> administrato<sup>r</sup> and assignes to the said william Earle of Exeter his heires and assignes that she the said Isabell Sismye her executo<sup>r</sup> administrato<sup>r</sup> and assignes shall and will from tyme to tyme during the said termes upon warnginge or notice given wch and truelie go forme and do her and their suete and service to the said william Earle of Exeter his heires and assignes to be held within or for the manor of Liddington aforesaid wher and as often as they or either of them shall haue to be kept and will and truelie pay x for me oblynes and kepe all the gemes penaltys orders by laws and constitutions wch shall be made assised or imposed upon her or them by the steward and juries of the said do<sup>e</sup> or either of them for the tyme beinge **And** likewise shall and will from tyme to tyme during the said termes gynd all her and their bothe grame and Mault to the or they shall expend within or upon the premisses att the Mill or Mills of the said william Earle of Exeter his heires and assignes in Liddington aforesaid and pay the toll accustomed for the same **And** also shall and will yeaill during the said termes with such competent number of Servantes or other persons as shall be needfull att her and their owne proper coste and charges and with her and their bothe brasse cattle plow and furniture therunto belonginge boore and labour two daies with the worke service and bulwars of the land within Earle of Exeter during his naturall life and after his dease of such other person and persons as shall haue the next and ymediate possession and remainder of the dimissh premisses att such tyme and tyme as she or they shall haue warnginge or notice therof given **And** the said william Earle of Exeter doth herby for himself his heires and assignes tooveute promise and graunte to and with the said Isabell Sismye her executo<sup>r</sup> administrato<sup>r</sup> and assignes that it shall and may be lawfull to and for her and them for and under the rent and tooveute aboue mentoned gracably and quietlie to haue hold rossesse and enoye the dimissh premisses and to their part therof during the said termes without the lanfull lefft trouble molestacion or interuption of the said william Earle of Exeter his heires or assignes **And** the said Richard Scall and David Scall doth herby likewise for themselves their heires and assignes tooveute promise and graunte to and with the said Isabell Sismye her executo<sup>r</sup> administrato<sup>r</sup> and assignes that it shall and may be lawfull to and for her and them for and under the rent and tooveute aboue mentioned gracably and quietlie to haue hold rossesse and enoye the dimissh premisses and to their part therof during the said termes without the lanfull lefft trouble molestacion or interuption of the said Richard Scall and David Scall or either of them their or either of their heires or assignes or ame of them or ame clameing by from or under them or ame of them **In witness** whereof the parties to this present Indentures haue hereunto sett their hands and Sealys the day and yere first aboue
