The freemen & leaseholders & tenants at will to perform fealty & do. Suite to give in their hands
& what they had & also the last honor or duty, but as to summing the freemen for m^o
honorant opposed it & nota in respect of their votes for benefits of the shire but as to such
as are not for my lords interest to dispell them for they do not hold of any other manory
though they never perform fealty which by law is due to be performed.

Enquire of the owners if any surt^o in their custody for a year last past or if any
Leaseholders had last year or any widow age in patron of any benefice of the shire
How these surt^o are 2: or 3: for each Town & are warranted by the shire. by
law altered at pleasure & are sworn into their office.

By the custom of the manor the youngest son or youngest daughter is heir but in case of
daughters each are admitted to an undivided share at common law.

In April 1718: admision granted to wounding of the church of a lot in laborer out the
Duch of Dorset & Northall into their white it appears that in April 1717: two
Northall surrendered the same to Henry Dutton & Robert the heirs of their bodies
so that without a recovery they have no good title for they are dead.

Mary the wife of Nathaniel Holms admitted Oct. 1725: as only daughter & heir
of Nathaniel Wright but must suffer a recovery to have the tail on Nathaniel
Holms her fathers admision in 1695: before she can be admitted to make a
good surt^o to any other person. I think there's no objection for a recovery -
the being throuly child on lawful marriage

April 1725: John Waterfield found heir of Anthony Waterfield to one Cottage in Addington
but anno Waterfield his rector has it for life therefore he refuses to be admitted to the
Reversion of it. Nota.
