

The Manor of Eddington

Memorandum that on the twenty second day of October
in Calderott in the County of Northumberland in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred &
thirty Thomas Wadd the elder Thomas Wadd his son & Thomas Slator customary -
tenants of the Manor afores' in open Court did surrender into the hands of the
Lord of the said Manors by the hands of John Blackwell Steward there by the lord
All that Messuage house & Homestead with all the appurts to the same belonging -
& all that farmes close in Suderton which was formerly purchased of John Fisher -
& all those two acres of pasture lying on the East part of the said farmes close &
all those seven lands there which were purchased of William Slye & one month or
half that piece of land there belonging to one Mr. Yead now or late of William -
Chapman & all lying within the hedge there at or near Suderton aforesaid & all
those two acres of arable land & grass ground lying dispersed as follows viz: one
land at Long Carron the lands now or late of Zachary the West one half acre -
lying at fields end the lands now or late of Mr. Blackwell Heath & three lands being
one acre lying in a certain place called Young matts the lands now or late of William -
King on the West with all & singular the appurts in Calderott aforesaid within the
Manor afores' & now or late in the tenure or occupation of William Chapman so -
the use & benefit of John Chapman the younger of Eddington aforesaid & his
heirs & assigns at the Will of the Lord according to the custom of the said Manors
