particularly as to Caldroff for this ought to be done by him as saye in By. yll or depu. Kees -  
of if such as are ffishholders & grassholders & tounants at Will & as also Jutnants are outed in the  
suit hold in their severall Capanies.

The ffishholders & grassholders & tounants at will to perform fealty & to give in their names  
& what they hold & who the last owner or tounant, but they are to compell the ffishholders for Mr.  
ffawmont opposed it & nota in respect of their votes for Knights of the Shire but they are to such as  
are not for my Lord's Interest to compell them for they do not hold of any other Mannor though they  
were performed fealty which by law is due to be performed.

The Bakers & Brewers to be pressed by the Surveyors of Weights & measures but not Mr. ffawmont  
opposed it however give it in charge.

Inquire of the assisors if any surrenders in their history for a year last past or if any Copyholders  
dead since last Court or any under age in possession of any Copyhold Estates. Note these assisors  
are two or three for each down & are named by the Steward & by him altered at pleasure & are sworn  
into their office.

In the custom of the Mannor the Youngest Son or Youngest Brother is heir but in case of daughters  
such are admitted to an undivided Share as at common law.

In April 1710: admision granted to William King of the Moish of a Cottage in Caldroff on the  
Sund of Henry Boulton & Martha his wife since which it appears that in April 1717 the s<sup>d</sup> Martha  
surrendered the same to Henry Boulton & her self & the heirs of their bodies so that without a recovery  
King has no good title after they are dead.

April 1725: John Waterhob found heir of Anthony Waterhob to one Cottage in Eddington but  
Anne Waterhob his mother had it for life therefore he refused to be admitted to the Reversion quod  
nota.
