of <sup>(22)</sup> thousand seven hundred and fifty one. Robert Shattoke & his younger son Edward of  
Hedington in his said husbandman one of his customary tenants of the said manor did out of court by  
Cessation xx. his rods Surveyor into his lands of the lord of the said manor by his hand and  
in his County Hertfordshire of Walter Ferriman Gentleman All that one quarter of a yard Lands of the lord of  
Gattington a meadow and pasture ground lying & being dispersedly in the several fields meadows & in land territory  
of calder of Aylesford and Hedington as follows in the said manor containing by estimation three acres more or less land all in  
one close or copy of grass ground lying at a place called Halsdon containing one acre (more or less) together also to the same  
place called Common & Common of Pastures for sheep & other cattle to the same belonging & appertaining and adjoyneth same all  
the same place called Halsdon as also all wayes passages roads banks brakcs ditches mounds & other hinder  
under wood trees & other timber & bridges harditam & all other premises to the said quarter  
so called belonging & appertaining and all the right title interest and possession reversion & reversion & claim & demand  
right & power of in the said quarter land he mess of grass ground every part thereof late in the occupation of Mathew  
in a dove to the only use and benefit of Thomas Tabison of Calder of Aylesford Gentleman and of  
his heirs and assigns forever according to the custom of the said manor.
