to the said Courts or either of them are personally to be & appear before the Clerk in the forenoon of the  
same day there & there to pay their rents & to do & perform their several suits & services according to the  
custom of the said Manner And you are also to summon & warn a sufficient number of fit persons  
to serve upon the Inquisition & Homage at the said Courts & to shew their several names in  
writing so summoned & sworn under my hand & seal this fourth day of October in the sixth year of the  
Reign of our Sovereign Lord King George the second of Great Britain &c. in the year of our Lord 1742.
