



And that Sir John Leyte hath surrendered into the hands of the lord by the hand of Master John and the attorney of the said maner and also in an estate of meadowes in ryng being a certaine part of the land of the maner of Wallakey to the use of the bishop of Chichester of his honor and his heirs and assigns for ever to whom the lord by his steward hath thereto granted to have and to hould the sayd meadowes in ryng unto the said Bishop of Chichester and his assigns for ever at the will of the lord according to the customes of the maner bounding or the lande aforesaid and out of all other comynge or heighing the lord shall have payment of the same.
