The xxij and twentieth Day of October 1653.

The Day and year above written James Winton and Mary  
his wife (the said Mary being Sololy and secretly xx  
examined by the Stewards) did Surrender into the hands  
of the Lord by the hands of his Stewards and Messnages  
w<sup>th</sup> the assent of the said James Winton or of his  
in the occupation of the said James Winton or of his  
assigned and Invoiced of an able land of the assent of  
in Liddington aforesaid late George Brownes and now or  
late also in the occupation of the said James Winton  
or of his assigned to the use and behoof of Jonathan  
hollod Edward Brown and Jeroniah hollod Clerk  
and of their heirs and assigns <sup>forever</sup> according to the custom  
of the Mannor of Liddington aforesaid

Upon this Condition notwithstanding that of the above named  
James Winton his heirs executors administrators or assigns or  
any of them shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto  
the abovesaid Jonathan hollod Edward Brown & Jeroniah  
hollod their certeyne Attorney executors or administrators the  
full and just some of good and lawfull money of England att one ontre payment att  
in and upon the last day of October w<sup>ch</sup> shall be in the year of  
our Lord Christ according to the attempt now used in England and  
thow said six hundred fiftie and fower w<sup>ch</sup> out fraud or further  
delaye then the above written Surrender to be void or else  
stand & remayne in full force and virtue: of

In witness whereof Jonathan hollod Edward Brown & Jeroniah hollod  
at Liddington the xxij day of October 1653 admittisunt bonis ad Messnages
