

Livingston plains made by the jurie at the
Court last Court Barren the 10th halfe the
30th day of October 1682 —

To be observed as followeth

- 1st — it is agreed that no person shall put in to the vpper
or nether Cow pasture but one Calf for a pasture
except it be a spanned fine maximal in pain of 10^o
- 2nd — it is agreed that no person shall tie down manure or
foales in any of our fields after the sole be five
weekes out in pain of 20^o day fault
except in watering in of manure
- 3rd — it is agreed that no person shall have any beards
or fillies follow his down in hay time whatsoe
in pain of 6^o 8^o
- 4th — it is agreed that no person shall glean any vpper
or barrie or pair or beane except the down or vpper
be first carried off the land in pain of
no more than 10^o for the down
- 5th — it is agreed that no person shall gather any pebbles
except it be of their own land or with sum of the
owners of the said land in pain of 5^o
- 6th — it is agreed that no person shall break down of the fields
until michaelmas day nor put down shoope in to
the said fields in pain of 10^o 5^o
- 7th — it is agreed that no person shall put down lime stath
in the morninge vpper the pasture until five time
that the heards do yett nor suffer them to continue longer
then the heards in pain of 10^o 5^o
- 8th — that no person shall put down shoope in to the heards in
pain of 20^o 5^o
- 9th — that no person shall mow down goas after Lammab
weir was dore dater since the first day of may
in pain of 10^o 5^o
- 10th — it is agreed that down person shall make his hedge by
meddow gate by the first day of may or with in
five dayes after so continue them till the fields be
barred in pain of 6^o 8^o
- 11th — that no man shall keep down by heards in pain of 5^o 5^o
- 12th — it is agreed that if down person hath any compass living
in the woods hee must remove it by the michaelmas
next day nor move them in pain of 6^o 8^o
- 13th — it is agreed that down person with in any town that
taketh common other for him or shoope shall give
notice thereof to sum one of the foremen of the fields
before his buttel enter there on in pain of 10^o 5^o
- 14th — it is agreed that no person shall down down hares
vpper the Cow pasture from Lammab until hee best
pasture be down the fields aforesaid to down of the said

- 15th — it is agreed that no person shall let down shoope down
least five nightes for down five in pain of

- 18th — it is agreed that no person shall let hares down
except hee let land proportionable with it in pain of 10^o
- 19th — it is agreed that no person shall keep down fire in his
hairs out a sufficient chimney in pain of 5^o

- 20 That all Land lordes shall Remaine all a before intallment
not all in matos out of thowr haufes ab by Law may
be put out of the town in paine of 10-0
- 21 That wherofen that cometh poded to bread and
hedges shall fulfill to the parties poded for above of some
and to be mortised to the Lord 2-6
- 22 That no ofen shall keep chine shoope above his Right
of Common in paine of above shoope so kept 1-0
- 23 That wherofen shall keep sufficient fowles but none
neighbour Choughs or falow his deames in paine of 10-0
- 24 That no ofen shall set chine meadows in any fields
but by the Consent of the furrow nor thow chine steno
from his one Lande upon his neighbours in paine of 10-0
- 25 it is agreed that no ofen shall keep horse Cow or shoope
above his Right of Common in paine of above fowles default
to pay 10-0
- 26 it is agreed that all persons that have taken in any ground
from the Kinges high waye or chine Common ground
or have made any in Brement shall have time to
twyft this the next Court to amend the same or for
above default so offending to forfeit 20-0
- 27 it is agreed that no inhabitant shall put any hogges in to
owr fields on Dunge in paine of 5-0
- 28 it is agreed that none having Cottage or tenement
in any town shall take any favours or strangers thow in
except he give sufficient band of fastiv pounds to fure
two ab shall be ofen by the Consent of the furrow for
the Quere of the same to distringe our town of any
charge it may happen by thow above then or at any
other time in furing that all the ofens and the tenent
shall other above the town or elf the Land lord thow of
shall then Remaine the forwithe according to the Choyse
of the two men ofen in paine of above default 10-0
- 29 it is agreed that no ofen shall carry chine fire by day or
by night except in allep thow in paine of 10-0
- 30 it is agreed that wherofen one of hath played by chine ball
or part of any ball with in any fielde since the last Court
shall lay the same down againe to have the chine next
Court shall play the same no more how after in paine
of above default so committed 5-0
- 31 it is agreed that no ofen shall make chine hie waies edge
borne paye or quab in paine of 3-4
- 32 it is agreed that upon Cross munday above mofage and
Cottage shall all the last pndow of above beinge fytte
years of age or above to go the waye of ambulation in
paine of above default so committed 3-4
- 33 it is agreed that wherofen it putteth any haye into
any field or be fore the haggard after the haggard be two
monthes oute shall pay the haggard fowre pntes alwy
quarterly in paine of above default 3-4
- 34 it is agreed that no ofen shall cast chine Garra in
or neare the town but his Land or high waye in
for above time so offending 10-0
- 35 it is agreed that if chine ofen shall in any chine part
of the field ground be above to the Custom of the maner
for above thow so offending shall forfeit 5-0
- 36 it is agreed that if chine ofen shall either or take any
chine hay or Cow in to the fowle field for above fowles
shall forfeit 10-0
- 37 it is agreed that if chine labourer or fith man or chine
other ofen shall carry chine quab or hay except off
his one ground shall forfeit for above default so offending

- 38 it is agreed that wherofen shall bring his one ground
from Brement and putteth into the top of above fowle with
above aforesaid chaffe of above dore be twyft
the Cladaye or for above fowles default to forfeit 10-0

40 - it is agreed that all of us shall take at three points
to hold out of the pituit. by St. Thomas & they all
Samuel's out of the great fat in point of 10 2

41 It is agreed that every officer that bears any
publick office shall give up their ^{7 days} accounts
before the others come on or within seven days
after the new ones are elected on pain of 20:00
