**First** that Robert Boyer Lawrence Browning Robert Carter Stephen Wright John Waterfield Thomas Lanter William Dargiford

Hemant Sherwood John Webster Robert Causley Anthony Causley William Ward and Thomas Grant have surcharged the common of sheep

And that the said John Waterfield Thomas Lanter and Thomas Grant have surcharged the common of sheep with laken in Anthony Causley as an inmate therefore they are amerced the several sums set up on their heads

And it was found by the homage that John Waterfield being seized of divers messuages tenement houses of the lord of this manor

in three common Sonage 13<sup>th</sup> suite of Court the yearly rent of 13<sup>d</sup> he offered the same by writ into Katherine his wife for life and after to Anthony

Waterfield his youngest sonne and other remainders void and that thereupon there happened to the lord for a whole 13<sup>d</sup>

rendering to the lord yearly one penny rent suit of all & they gave the lord a fine for admittance of house made  
the said care admitted lxx
