this manor and doff in Snellson and one halfe yard land therinto belonging to the apertures in Goldscott do the 26 and before the death of Walter
Sneyd he had his bonds and of his heart and assigned for ever to whom the Lord by his steward hath thereto granted Seizyn to have and to hold
the said doff halfe yard land and remis to the apertures unto the sayd Walter Sneyd bound his bonds and assigned for ever to the will
of the Lord according to the customs of the said manor rendering to the Lord yearly 5^l rent unto the doff and other summes therfore due
and accustomed he gave the Lord a tynt for his admittance to have the same hath made Acquited and so admittede consent.

At this Court it was Certified that Elme Winton an infant of the age of fifteene, dares on threabonter a sonant of certane custome land
and demesne holden of the Lord of this manor hath dislayned and discharged James Winton her unto found his her guardians and
in his place and stead appointed her mother Elme Curmer now wife of Mr Henry Curmer to haue the full enjoun of her according to law.
