

The Maner of Eddington

in Caldroth in the County of Rutland

Memorandum that on the twentieth second day of October in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & thirty Thomas Wade the Elder Thomas Wade his Son & Thomas Slater customary tenants of the Maner aforesaid in open Court did surrender into the hands of the Lord of the said Maner by the hands of John Blackwell Steward there by the word All that Messuages house & homestead with all the appurtenances to the same belonging & all that Tanneries close in Sudleston which was formerly purchased of Rowland Fisher & all those two Acres of pasture lying on the East part of the said Tanneries close & all those seven Acres there which were purchased of William Sly & one Maister or half that piece of land there belonging to one Leonard Land now or late of William Chapman & all lying within the hedges there at or near Sudleston aforesaid & all those two acres of arable land & grass ground lying dispersedly as follows viz: one land at long Carman the land now or late of Zachary New West one half acre lying at Kildes and the land now or late of Mr. Blackwell North & these lands being one acre lying in a certain place called Young natts the land now or late of William King on the West with all & singular the appurtenances in Caldroth aforesaid within the Maner aforesaid & now or late in the tenure or occupation of William Chapman do the use & behoof of John Chapman the Younger of Eddington aforesaid & of his heirs & assigns at the Will of the Lord according to the custom of the said Maner
