into the hands of the Lord of the said Manor. by the hands of the
aforesaid Steward all that messuages or townsh. by way of
stables outhouses & other edifices & close of pasture heretofore
belonging in the said Manor of their appurtenances now in the possession
of the said Robert Boyer do the use & behoof of Magdalen
Cyprian of Ippingham in the County of Rutland widow
& of her heirs & assigns for ever according to the customs
of the said Manor. Upon this proviso & condition
Notwithstanding that if the said Robert Boyer or Elizabeth his
wife their heirs or assigns or any of them do & shall
well & truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Magdalen Cyprian
her heirs & assigns the full contented sum
of fiftie pounds of good & lawfull money of England
with the lawfull interest & interest thereof of the money
on the said twentieth day of September next ensuing
the date hereof then this surrender to be void & of no
effect.
