Will proved 1666

1 In the name of God Amen  
2 The Two and Twentieth day of October One Thousand Six Hundred  
3 Fifty and Eight I Katherine Falkener of Uppingham in the County of  
4 Roteland widdow Executrix of the last Will and Testament of Lyon Falke-  
5 ner *gentleman* deceased being in perfect memory and understanding (Thanks  
6 be given to God Almighty) Doe revoake all former wills by me made  
7 And doe make and ordaine this my last will and Testament in manner and  
8 forme following First and above all things I resigne my soule unto the  
9 hands of the holy and blessed Trinity from whence I received the same hoping  
10 through the death and Passion of my Lord and Savior Jesus Christ  
11 my sinnes shall be remitted And my soule saved And as touching my  
12 reall and [*illeg.*]duall Estate which the Lord hath blessed me withall I  
13 Bequeath as followeth Item I give unto the Minister that shall  
14 Preach my funerall service the summe of Twenty shillings Item I  
15 give to my loveing Cosen Mr Edward Chisledine the summe of Ten shillings  
16 in remembrance of my love hoping hee will be ayding and assisting  
17 To this my Executor if need require Item I give to Thomas Marston  
18 my faithfull servant the summe of Tenn shillings Item I give to Mary  
19 Pakeman the summe of Tenn shillings Item I give to Prudence Luoy  
20 Widdow an antient servant the summe of Tenn shillings to be paid her at  
21 The Annunciation of the Blessed Virgin Mary Next ensueing the summe  
22 of Five shillings And att St Michaell the Archangell next following the  
23 Other Five shillings And soe every yeare proporcionably as before said for long  
24 as shee liveth Item I give and bequeath to Anthony Falkener my youngest  
25 sonne and his heires for ever All that my Freehold and Leasehold Lands  
26 and Tenements with their appurtenances in Lyddington Seton Thorpe Caldecott  
27 alias Caucott Stoke Dryall in the County of Roteland or within the townes  
28 Feilds or Territories of them or any of which were formerly the lands  
29 and Tenements of Frances Watson *gentleman* And now or late in the  
30 Occupation of John Prettyman Esquire Item I give and bequeath All  
31 and singular my Leasehold Closes and Meadows which I hold by Lease  
32 for the life of George Sheffield *gentleman* and others lying and being  
33 within the Townes or Feilds aforesaid unto Anthony Falkener my youngest  
34 sonne for ever Item I give and bequeath All that my Lease of the  
35 Pickidge and Stallidge with other lands and Tenements there unto be-  
36 longing Lyeing and being within the Townes Feilds and Territories of  
37 Uppingham Preston Wing Glaston Pisbrooke *alias* Bisbrooke within the  
38 County of Roteland unto Anthony Falkener my youngest sonne his heires  
39 and assignes for ever All my Legacies Debts and funeral expenses dis-  
40 charged I doe make Anthony Falkener my youngest sonne sole Executor  
41 of this my last Will and Testament And in remembrance of my true love  
42 and service I doe give to Jeffery Palmer Esquire the summe of [*blank*]  
43 hoping if any difference should arise concerning this my last Will and  
44 Testament he will Lend his best assistance to end and determine the same  
45 And if he should refuse I hope Mr Theodore Greene will lay his helping

46 hand to determine the same And in remembrance of my love I give him the  
47 summe of [*blank*] Witnes my hand and seale the day and yeare above  
48 said Katherine Falkener. Sealed and delivered in the presence of  
49 Thomas Marston his marke Mary Pakeman her marke.
