**Will proved 1673**

### **LAO Lidd will 5**

1 In the Name of God Amen. I Richard Hill  
2 of Caldecot Doe make this My last will and  
3 testament as followeth first I bequeath my Soule  
4 to Almighty God *which* Gave it me and my body  
5 to be buried in th<sup>e</sup> Churchyard of Caldecoote and  
6 for my goods & Chattells I bequeath in *Manner* as  
7 followeth Imprimis I give to Jane my Wife one  
8 red cow three sheep and all th<sup>e</sup> houshold goods which  
9 shee brought and for th<sup>e</sup> house at Esten she  
10 shall have soe longe as she continues a Widdow  
11 item I Give unto my Sonne William Hill  
12 all my horses cows sheep and hoggs \&/ all the rest  
13 of my Goods which be left *wi<sup>th</sup>* th<sup>e</sup> mony and all  
14 the rest of th<sup>e</sup> things which I have and doe  
15 make him my full & Sole Executor and for  
16 my funerall Charges My Mind is that ~~they both~~ \he/  
17 shall ~~share~~ \provide/ for funerall charges  
18 In Witnes Whereof I have hereunto sett my  
19 hand and seale, February th<sup>e</sup> 17th 1672
