1 In the name of God Amen I Nickolas Jordan of Thorpe in
2 Cowntey of Rutland yoman being in good & pressent memorye at

4 Macker & Redeemer I Ordayne This my last will & Tesstament in
5 maner & forme as Fowloweth first I bequeath my sole unto the
6 Allmighteye God my macker & Redeemer Item I will that my bodey
7 shall be Bewried in the Parish Churchyard of Lidinton
8 Item I give unto my wife Constant Jordan all her howsall goods
9 which weare her owne which shee brought with her
10 Item I give her ten sheepe with two Cowes whearof shee shall
11 mack Choyce of one and my son William shall give her another
12 & Thaye To be mainetained heare whill the sekkond daye of feberarye
13 be in cawled by the pewryefikation of marye

33 more over my wife is to paye the tith dew for the Cotege hows
34 to the Vicker of lidinton the sum of six shillins & eight pence
35 & the Clarckes wagis dew to be payd at saynt mickall next
