1 In the name of God Amen I Thomas Langdale of Caldecot
2 in the County of Rutland being sicke in bodey but
3 In *perfect* memory doe make this my last will and
4 Testament as foloweth *Imprimis* I ~~give~~ bequeath my soule
5 to alemighty god and my body to be buried by the
6 discesion of of my executrix Ittem I give all my goods
7 and Chattels unto my wife to be used and dissposed
8 of at her will and pleasure ownly I give to my ~~sonne John~~
9 ~~one shilling and to my~~ daughter Sary one shilling ~~and to~~
10 ~~my daughter Susanna four shillings~~ And I doe make my
11 wife Elizabeth Langdale full and soule executrix of this
12 my last will and Testament \dated/ May the third day of may
13 in the year of our lord one thousand six hundred seventy
14 and five
15 memorandum I doe further give to my kinswoman
16 Susanna Gladwin forty shillings to be payd
17 within a year after my decease
18 Signed in the presents of
19 Wittnes Ever: Parker

Granted 4th April 1676 at Gretton in Rutland by Thomas Arnold to Elizabeth relict.
