1 In The name of God Amen  
2 This Fourteenth day of January In the yeare of our Lord Christ  
3 one Thousand Six Hundred Seaventy and one And in the Twenty  
4 Third yeare of the Reigne of our Sovereign King Charles The  
5 Second King of England Scotland France and Ireland defender of the Faith  
6 *etc* I Robert Pelsant of Liddington in the County of Rutland gentleman  
7 being in good health and perfect memory And hereby Revoking all  
8 former Wills and Testaments Doe make and ordaine this my last will  
9 and Testament in manner and forme following Imprimis I give and  
10 bequeath my soul to Almighty God who gave it Trusting firmly through  
11 the meritts of Jesus Christ my Saviour To live with him Eternally Item  
12 I give and bequeath To the Poore of Liddington aforesaid Two pounds Item  
13 I give and bequeath To each of the Children of Sir Eusebis Pelsant my  
14 Brother One Pound Item I give and bequeat to my Cosin Mary Leigh  
15 Tenn Shillings Item I give and bequeath to my loveing Brother Sir  
16 Eusebie Pelsant my Tythes of Liddington and Coldecott And I doe hereby  
17 Release to my said loveing brother All my Right Title and Interest in and  
18 To the Prebend or Parsonage of Liddington aforesaid Item I give and  
19 bequeath to my said Loveing Brother All my goods and Chattells undisposed  
20 And I make and ordaine my said loveing Brother Sole Executor of this  
21 my last will and Testament In witnes whereof I have sett my hand and  
22 Seale The day and yeare First above written Robert Pelsant. Witness  
23 Thomas Sharpe Edward Cooper The marke of John Smith The marke of  
24 William Aire The marke of Edward Knight
