**Elizabeth PRETTY, nurse of Lyddington**

**Will proved 1821**

**ROLLR DE 73/66**

1 This is the last Will and Testament of me Elizabeth Pretty of  
2 Liddington in the County of Rutland Spinster now one of the Nurses in the Hospital  
3 of Liddington – I give and bequeath the following Legacies (viz) To my nephew Townsend  
4 Pretty\or his heires/of Manton in the said County of Rutland Shoemaker the sum of Twenty  
Pounds  
5 of lawful money of Great Britain – To Peter Pretty\or his heires/of Liddington aforesaid  
Laborer  
6 Fiveteen pounds and my Bed Bedstead and Hangings – To Mary the Wife of William  
7 Aunsby\or his heires/of Halloughton in the County of Leicester Tailer twenty pounds and my  
8 Chest of Drawers – To William Pretty, John Pretty, Millicent the Wife of Edward  
9 Baines and Mary Pretty the Sons and Daughters of my nephew William Pretty  
10 of Liddington aforesaid Shoemaker two pounds a piece – Also I give and bequeath  
11 to the said Mary the Wife of William Aunsby and Millicent the Wife of Edward  
12 Baines All my Plate China and Wearing Apparel to be equally divided between  
13 them share and share alike – Also give and bequeath to Robert Pretty of  
14 North Luffenham Son of my late Nephew Robert Pretty deceased Two pounds –  
15 And I direct that all the before mentioned Legacies shall be paid by my Executor  
16 hereinafter named within twelve months after my decease – Also I give and bequeath  
17 to the said William Pretty my Tea Table And all the rest residue and remainder  
18 of my monies personal estate and Effects whatsoever and wheresoever of what  
19 nature or kindsoever I give and bequeath unto my said Nephew William Pretty  
20 absolutely whom I appoint Executor of this my last Will and Testament –  
21 In Witness whereof I the said Elizabeth Pretty the Testatrix have hereunto set  
22 my hand and seal this – fourth day of October in the year of our Lord  
23 One thousand eight hundred and fifteen. –  
24 The Mark of + Elizabeth Pretty  
25 Signed sealed Published and Declared by the  
26 said Elizabeth Pretty the Testatrix as and for  
27 her last Will and Testament in the presence of us  
28 who in her presence at her request and in the –  
29 presence of each other have subscribed our

45 sum of one hundred and fifty pounds
